THE UNEMPLOYED ACT. ORDER BY THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT BOARD.

The Local Government Board for Scotland has issued an order regarding the Unemployed Act, 1905.

Article I.—In this Order, unless the contrary intention appears, the expression "the Act" means the Unemployed Workmen Act, 1905, and the expression "burgh" means and includes each Royal Burgh, Parliamentary or police burgh with a population of not less than 50,000.

(1) The boundaries of burghs shall be held to be those ascertained as ascertained, fixed, or determined for police purposes.

(2) The District Committee shall consist of the total number of members specified in relation to the burgh in column six of the schedule to this Order.

(3) One member at least of the district committee shall be a member of the burgh in relation to which the committee is appointed.
